


# Instructions For Downloading Software from the Svoboda Lab Website

All software available for download is accessible through the web. Downloads of both the software files (as ZIP files) as well as documentation (either PDF or DOC files) are available in an organized fashion from the Svoboda lab web server. Here we describe the process of downloading software from the website.

## Registration

While all software is available for free, we require the user to register once before they download any application(s) in order to monitor where and how the software is being used. The login information is saved and used to update users of the software of updates that are available for download as well as new software posted to the server. Based on the registration information, no one is denied access to the software. It is merely a convenient way for the lab to oversee the distribution and updating process. Information collected will be kept private and not distributed.

The main software page may be accessed by going to the website: [svobodalab.cshl.edu/software\\_main.html](http://svobodalab.cshl.edu/software_main.html). This page is reproduced in **Figure 1**. The bottom section highlights the options for accessing the software: **Registration** and **Login**.

If the user has visited the site before and has a valid username and password, they may check the software page whenever they want, gaining access to new software and updates of old software and documentation. This is **Login** access to the software. Updates to the software will be advertised using the email information supplied by the user, as well as information on new software. The user may of course not receive updates if they wish.

New users need to **Register** before gaining access to the software. This is done from the main page by selecting the **Register** link in the main registration page (**Figure 1**). This brings the user to the main registration page (**Figure 2**). The information required is the user's first and last name, affiliation (either school name, lab name, institution, etc...), position at their respective place of employment, their email address, as well as a unique username and password.

After filling in the fields on the registration page, the user hits submit. If there are any fields not filled in correctly, the browser will display the incorrect selections in red at the top of the page. If the information is valid, the information is saved to the user database and confirmation of the registration is displayed in the

browser (Figure 3). The user is then redirected to the software page to download any available software or documentation.

Once registered, there are no restrictions on accessing the software. It can be done as many times as the user pleases. The main software page (Figure 4) shows the relevant license and copyright information, as well as the software available for download. The software is listed by name (ScanImage 2.0) followed by a brief description of the software (Laser Scanning Microscope Software).

The two links that follow direct the user the location of the software stored as a ZIP file (Download). Since most of the software is for Matlab, it is a collection of files that needs to be placed on the Matlab path. Details on installing the applications are detailed in the Documentation, which can be opened and saved as either a Microsoft Word Document (DOC) or an Adobe Acrobat PDF file. Next to the Documentation link is any additional information, including any updates made recently to the software.
